Overview

The Transportation Working Group promotes a sustainable, resilient, and multi-modal transportation network at UVA, supporting the University's greenhouse gas reduction goals and enhancing accessibility to Grounds.

The Transportation Working Group educates students, faculty, and staff about sustainable transportation options, including transit, carpool, vanpool, walk, bike, and dockless mobility programs such as e-scooters. Students, faculty, and staff can collaborate to identify parking and transportation infrastructure improvements and opportunities for new mobility programs.

Goals or Projects

- **Electric Bus Task Force** – Students, faculty, and staff are collaborating to develop a proposal to bring the first electric bus(es) to Grounds.
