Overview

The Clean Water Working Group focuses on improving stormwater management practices and the sustainable usage of water at UVA. The working group is composed of both students and staff/faculty. The students are given the opportunity and resources to investigate and recommend stormwater practices that will reduce U.VA.'s impacts on our local streams, rivers and the Chesapeake Bay. These efforts will also be instrumental in our community meeting the regulatory TMDL goals established by the Virginia DEQ and DCR.

Goals or Projects

- Promotion of stormwater pollution prevention / storm drain mural contest
 - Treat on-site stormwater runoff / Bioretention Basins
 - Promotion of stormwater pollution prevention / Glue storm drain stickers on sidewalks
 - Outreach / Host a fall stream clean up

Storm drain stickers have already been placed around the hospital complex and inside/outside of Scott Stadium. Approval for Facilities Management cistern. H2O 2 GO is continuing to provide drinking water for large-scale events and reducing the need for plastic water bottles.
