

Recycling

- Aluminum, cardboard, glass of all colors, plastics #1-7, and white and mixed office paper can all be recycled at UVA!
- Electronic recycling, or e-cycling, is also available
- Students in on-grounds housing are provided two bins: one for papers, the other for plastic, metals, and glass
- Cardboard can also be recycled on-grounds in labeled bins!

Composting

- UVA has teamed up with Blackbear Composting, which collects food waste, uncoated paper, and other BPI-certified items
- Zero-waste events can be hosted
 - CIOs can complete Zero Waste Training, then request compost bin and compostable wares from UVA Recycling for events

- Composting in O-Hill, Runk, and Newcomb Dining Halls
- Residents of Brown College, Hereford, and the IRC have access to compost bins
- West Range and Fine Arts Cafe- can bring your compostable items during cafe hours
- Newcomb- CIOs that have completed Zero Waste Training can use the compost bin outside of Newcomb

Recycling

- Outside of dorm buildings
- Available in most academic buildings



Recycling Programs

ROSE

Reusable Office Supply Exchange- collects new or gently used office supplies and distributes to the UVA community

Merci

A medical supplies recycling program that gives unused medical supplies to humanitarian organizations

ReUSE Store

Sells surplus property (chairs, desks, lamps, etc) to UVA community, also has public sale days
